KEY POINTS

- The ANZAC Eve Youth Vigil is a community event coordinated by the Returned & Services League of Australia (SA Branch) (RSL SA) which provides young South Australians with the opportunity to be involved with ANZAC traditions.
- The Vigil will be held at the South Australian National War Memorial on North Terrace in Adelaide, from 6.00pm on Tuesday 24 April 2018. Official guests are asked to arrive at 7.00pm, where they will be met by a host and escorted to seating in the viewing area.
- The Department of Human Services provides sponsorship of \$4,000 towards the costs of running the Vigil.
- As the Minister responsible for youth, you will be invited to co-sign Certificates of Recognition for each young person participating in the Vigil.

DISCUSSION

Up to 400 young people from ethnic and community groups, including youth representatives from indigenous communities, participate in the ANZAC Eve Youth Vigil each year.

In preparation for this year's event, the Department of Human Services provided the RSL with contact information for various multicultural groups, representing countries that served as allies to Australia in conflicts, to invite youth representatives to participate in the Vigil.

The Government of South Australia, through the former youth portfolio, has supported the Vigil since 2006-07. In 2016, annual sponsorship for the event was raised from \$2,000 to \$4,000 to assist the RSL with essential equipment and services for the event. Sponsorship of the event remains at \$4,000 per annum.

The Vigil will be held at the South Australian National War Memorial on North Terrace in Adelaide, from 6.00pm on Tuesday 24 April 2018.

Official guests are asked to arrive at 7.00pm, where they will be met by a host and escorted to seats in the viewing area.

Guests will watch the Dedication Ceremony, which will be attended by members of participating youth organisations, including representatives from multicultural groups as detailed above. Wreaths and tributes will be placed on the Memorial by the participating youth.

As part of its support of the event, the Department purchases books relating to the ANZAC tradition for the selected multicultural youth representatives to place as a tribute. The books are later donated to local schools through the South Australian Multicultural and Ethnic Affairs Commission.

At the conclusion of the Ceremony (approximately 8.20pm), you will be invited back to the Guest Marquee to share a light super with His Excellency the Governor of South Australia, the Honourable Hieu Van Le AC, Mrs Lan Le, government representatives, youth representatives and members of the RSL SA's ANZAC Eve Youth Vigil Committee. This portion of the event is scheduled to conclude with the departure of His Excellency at approximately 9.15pm.

As the Minister responsible for youth affairs, you will be invited to co-sign Certificates of Recognition for each young person participating in the Vigil. The certificates will be forwarded to you for signing after ANZAC Day.




