Men's Referral Service – support for men

- The Men's Referral Service is available to South Australian men for advice and help about their use of violence and to connect with local domestic violence services. Call the Men's Referral Service on **1300 766 491** at any time.
- The Men's Referral Service can connect you with local domestic violence services, OARS and Kornar Winmil Yunti (KWY).
- You can phone the Men's Referral Service 24 hours, 7 days a week on **1300 766 491**
- Every South Australian has a role to play in ending domestic, family and sexual violence.
- We are all urged to remain vigilant and for men and women to seek help if they need it.

Domestic Violence Crisis Line – support for women
