### **Freedom of information application**

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* received by the Office of the Minister for Human Services on 26 June 2018 seeking access to:

*Copies of any and all documents (including but not limited to physical and electronic material) regarding DHS Signed Briefing by Minister Lensink 18MHS/0085.*

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of my determination.

Three documents have been located that are relevant to your request and I have determined to release two documents in full and one in part. One document contains the mobile phone number of a staff member, personal information that I consider would be unreasonable to release, and I have therefore determined this information to be exempt pursuant to clause 6(1) of Schedule 1 of the Act.

Please find enclosed a copy of the documents, and a document schedule containing a brief description of the documents.

If you are dissatisfied with my determination, you can seek an internal review by writing to the Minister for Human Services as the Principal Officer of the agency. Your request should be sent within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

In accordance with the requirements of Premier and Cabinet Circular PC045, details of your FOI application, and the documents to which you are given access, will be published on the agency's disclosure log. 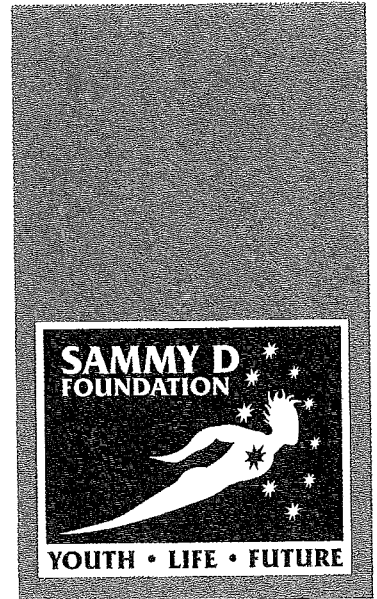

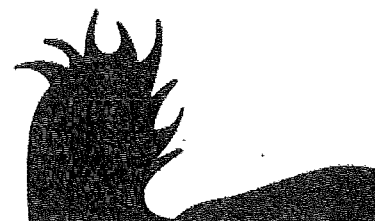

**DISCUSSION**

**The Sammy D Foundation**

Ms Natalie Cook MP, Member for Hurtle Vale and Mr Neil Davis founded the Sammy D Foundation after their son, Sam Davis, was the victim of an unprovoked one-punch assault that ended his life in 2008. The primary aim of the organisation is to provide skills to young people that prevent such a tragedy from happening in the community again.

Sammy D Foundation staff and volunteers deliver a range of programs in the South Australian community focused on encouraging young people to achieve their life potential, and empowering them to make safe and positive life choices. Foundation programs include:

- **Impact:** presentations and workshops that educate young people about the consequences of violence and the need to make safe choices when in private and public spaces.
- **Connect:** highly trained and motivated role models provide mentorship to vulnerable, disadvantaged, disengaged and socially excluded young people in either a group or one to one relationship.
- **Party Wise:** a program that uses a harm minimisation approach to alcohol and drug education and provides young people with strategies to keep celebrations safe. SA Police and SA Ambulance Service are program partners.

#### **The Gala Dinner**

This year's dinner commemorates the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Sam Davis' passing, and celebrates the achievements of the Foundation. The event will be attended by community leaders, well known personalities and individuals who are committed to the Sammy D Foundation's mission and vision. The night features a three course meal with fine wines, guest speakers, and entertainment.

#### **Funding and grants**

During 2016/17 Grants SA provided funding to the Sammy D Foundation:

- In 2016/17 the Sammy D Foundation received \$48,213 funding through Grants SA Major Round 2 toward the cost of their Youth Justice Community Engagement Program.
- In 2016/17 the Sammy D Foundation received \$2,882 funding through Grants SA Minor Round 4 toward the cost of Impact equipment funding.
- In 2016/17 the Sammy D Foundation received \$1,195 funding through Grants SA Minor Round 5 toward the cost of their Connect Mentoring Engagement – equipment funding.


