Freedom of information application

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), received by the Office of the Minister for Human Services on 17 October 2018 seeking access to:

Copies of any and all documents (including but not limited to physical and electronic material) regarding DHS or Ministerial Paper 18TDHS/798.

Unfortunately, a determination was unable to made within the 30 days, therefore it is considered to be a 'deemed refusal' under section 19(2)(b) of the Act. However, our office has continued to process your application outside of this timeframe. Section 19(2)(a) of the Act provides that an agency can release documents outside of the thirty-day timeframe, and this is still taken to be a determination under the Act.

Two documents have been identified as falling within the scope of your application and I have determined to release the documents in full.

Please find enclosed a copy of the documents, and a document schedule containing a brief description of the documents.



KEY POINTS

- Further to your recent approval of the Department of Human Services (DHS) Financial Authorisations on 22 May 2018 (attached), it is necessary to obtain your approval of the attached Authority to Execute Documents - Instrument of Authorisation which authorises certain people within DHS to execute documents by signing and/ or affixing the common seal on your behalf.
- With recent Machinery of Government changes, it is necessary to seek and secure new authorisations in accordance with Treasurer's Instruction 8.
- The Authority to Execute Documents Instrument of Authorisation will be effective from the date of your approval.

DISCUSSION

To promote administrative efficiency, it is necessary for certain people within DHS to execute documents by signing and / or affixing the common seal on your behalf.

On 22 May 2018, you approved the Financial Authorisations which included Contract Authorisation for DHS. Further to your approval of the Financial Authorisations, it is necessary to obtain your separate approval to allow certain people within DHS to execute documents on your behalf by signing and / or affixing the common seal.

The form and content of the Authority to Execute Documents - Instrument of Authorisation complies with Treasurer's Instruction 8.12 which specifies that:

- 8.12 An instrument empowering an employee or the occupant of a position to provide a contract authorisation must:
 - 8.12.1 be in writing;
 - 8.12.2 specify the employee, or the position (subject to clause 8.8.3)
 - 8.12.3 specify the monetary limit (to be less than \$1,500,000) and any other relevant terms and conditions (such as the type of contract or purchase for which the contract authorisation may be provided); and
 - 8.12.4 specify that it immediately ceases upon the employee ceasing employment or materially changing duties, or in relation to a position, a material change in the nature of the duties assigned to that particular position.
