Freedom of information application

I refer to your application under the *Freedom of Information Act 1991* (the Act), received by the Office of the Minister for Human Services on 28 February 2019 seeking access to:

After consultation with your office on the 8 March 2019, it was agreed to combine two of the freedom of information requests as referenced above, into one response.

Unfortunately, a determination was unable to made within the 30 days, therefore it is considered to be a 'deemed refusal' under section 19(2)(b) of the Act. However, our office has continued to process your application outside of this timeframe. Section 19(2)(a) of the Act provides that an agency can release documents outside of the thirty-day timeframe, and this is still taken to be a determination under the Act.

One document has been identified as falling within the scope of your application and I have determined to release this document in full.

Please find enclosed a copy of the document, and a document schedule containing a brief description of the document.

If you are dissatisfied with my determination, you can seek an internal review by writing to the Minister for Human Services as the Principal Officer of the agency. Your request should be sent within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

Resolved on the Committee's own motion that ~

The Committee inquire into, and report on the provision of services for people with mental illness under the transition to the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) with particular reference to:

- 1. The gap between the Federal Government's predicted and realised percentages of mental health clients receiving NDIS support;
- 2. The reduction in funding to the Personal Helpers and Mentors program and Mental Health Respite Carer Support program and the impact this will have on people with mental illness;
- 3. The ongoing requirements for block funded mental health services provided by the State Government after the NDIS transition;
- 4. The effects on South Australians with mental health issues who are deemed ineligible to receive NDIS funding;
- 5. The sufficiency of services provided to people with mental illness who are accepted into the NDIS;
- 6. The effects on South Australians with mental health issues undertaking the application process for the NDIS;
- 7. Any other relevant matters.

Any person or organisation wishing to make a written submission or register an interest in presenting oral evidence is invited to do so by Monday 29 October, 2018. Please note submissions will be made publically available unless determined otherwise by the Committee. Submissions that address issues outside the terms of reference may not be accepted.

With regard to the hearing of evidence, the Committee reserves the right to determine which witnesses will be invited to provide an oral submission.
